

POLICY STATEMENT EXTRA CURRICULAR

It is the policy of this school to foster as broad an education as possible in keeping with the school's Mission Statement and Aims.

The following extra curricular provision is made by staff members on a voluntary basis:

A wide range of extra-curricular activities are promoted.

Sports: football, basketball, athletics, swimming, horse-riding and golf

Music: instrumental music, choir/singing, dancing and school concert

Irish Language: Various events including Seachtain na Gaeilge which includes activities such as Touring Drama Groups, Fleadh, Quizes, Art competitions and guest speakers such as Maidhc Dainín Ó Sé(R.I.P).
